



Canada Post Strike Info

Banking-related documents
can be accessed via Online
Banking **at any time.**

Canada Post workers are officially on strike as of Friday morning, November 15, 2024 after the Canadian Union of Postal Workers (CUPW) and Canada Post failed to reach a negotiated settlement. This strike affects mail and parcel delivery Canada-wide.

Delivery Delays

With Canada Post workers officially on strike, delivery of Provincial Credit Union related documents may be delayed or interrupted.

Provincial Credit Union is monitoring the situation. We will ensure that despite delivery challenges, you can access the information you need at all times.

Online Banking

Banking-related documents, including monthly statements, product renewal notices, and more, can be accessed via Online Banking at any time.

If you have not signed up for Online Banking, you can call us or visit your local Provincial Credit Union branch for further assistance.

Direct Deposits and Direct Payments

Our staff can help you establish direct deposits, allowing you to conveniently receive your expected funds directly into your account. Additionally, we can assist in setting up pre-authorized debits to ensure that no payments are missed.

If you receive government cheques (CPP, OAS, Canada Child Benefits, etc.), Canada Post has agreed to continue delivering these cheques once a month.
